### Important Information

- Please inform us if your child will not be attending the Out of School Care program or if your child is registered in any after school activities or clubs at the school either by phone at 403-254-0288 or at [midnaporeoosc@midsun.org](mailto:midnaporeoosc@midsun.org) as the school will not let us know. There is a \$10 charge for not notifying the program.
- **Provincial Regulations state that you cannot send a child that has had a fever, vomited, diarrhea, new unexplained rash, or displays any symptoms that may compromise any other child or staff for 24 hours after symptoms subside. A doctor's note will be required to send your child within this 24 hour time frame stating that the child is not infectious and may return to care.**
- Please let the Out of School Care staff know about any changes to personal information such as a change in address, phone number at home or work, or any new medication or change thereof, etc...
