

Mid-Sun Community Centre Drop-In Pickleball Rules

1. Beginner / Advancing Beginner games are to 9 points win by 1 point.
2. Intermediate / Advanced games are rally point to 15 win by 2 points.
3. The team next to the curtain serves first at the start of a game.
4. Always announce the score before serving and do not return the serve if you did not understand or agree with the declared score.
5. Servers can step into the court to serve due to the limited space behind the baseline.
6. Only the receiving team can call a ball OUT (arm and finger pointed upward) once the ball has hit the floor. When in doubt, the opponents will be granted the advantage with no replays to decide.
7. Any ball hitting the basketball apparatus is deemed out of play and does not demand a re-serve.
8. On the end courts, players who cannot safely return a shot due to interference from the side wall, non-players, or personal items on the floor should ask for a re-serve.
9. All players will quickly exit the court on game completion, remaining alert with no discussion on route, and place their paddles in the paddle rack.
10. When a game finishes on Courts 2-3, players on Courts 1-2 move over to continue play.
